The renovation measures make sure that the real estate complies with modern building standards. Caverion installs, for instance, seven ventilation systems and 150 square metres of chilled sails to ensure a good indoor climate.

In many comparable projects, like the revitalisation of the Telekom headquarters in Bonn, Caverion has proved its competence," says **Werner Kühn**, Executive Vice President & CEO, Caverion's Germany division.
